Career Services will educate students and alumni and connect them with the employment community to ensure successful transitions from academia to the work force.

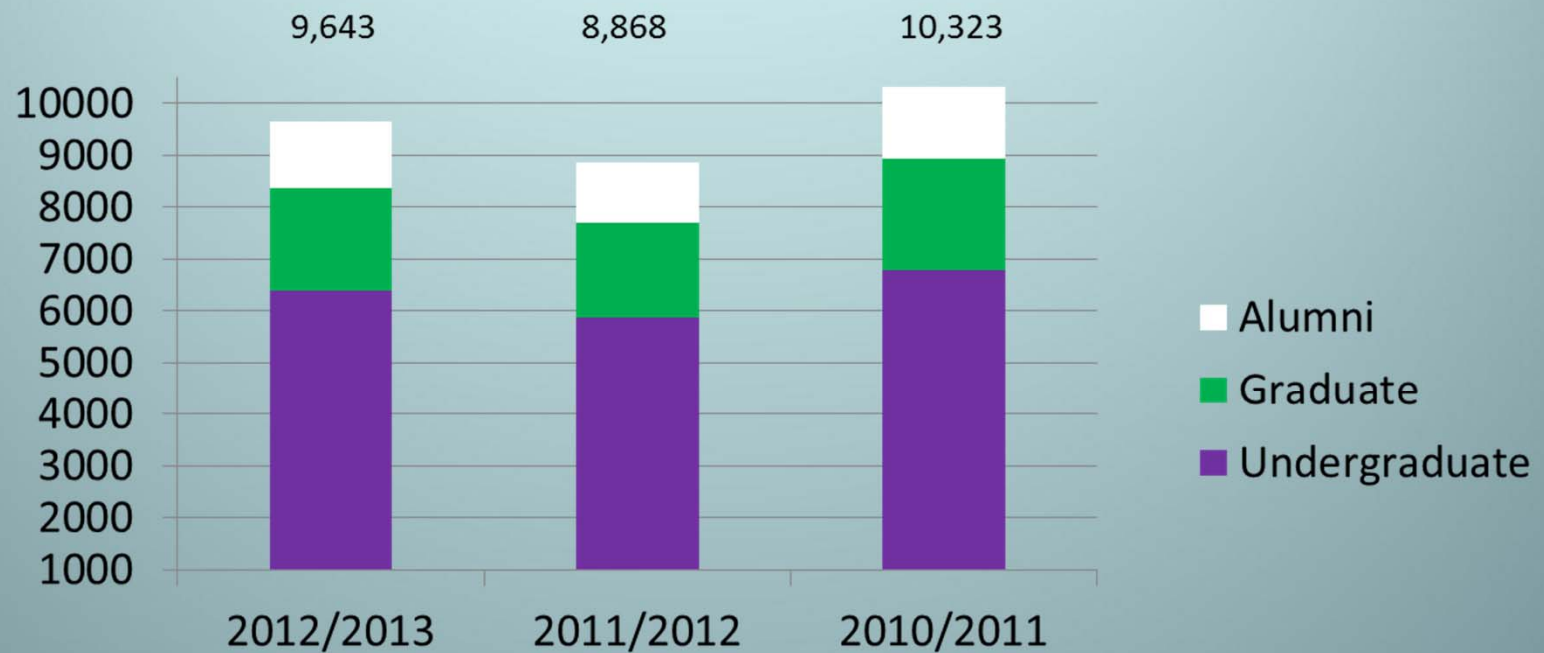

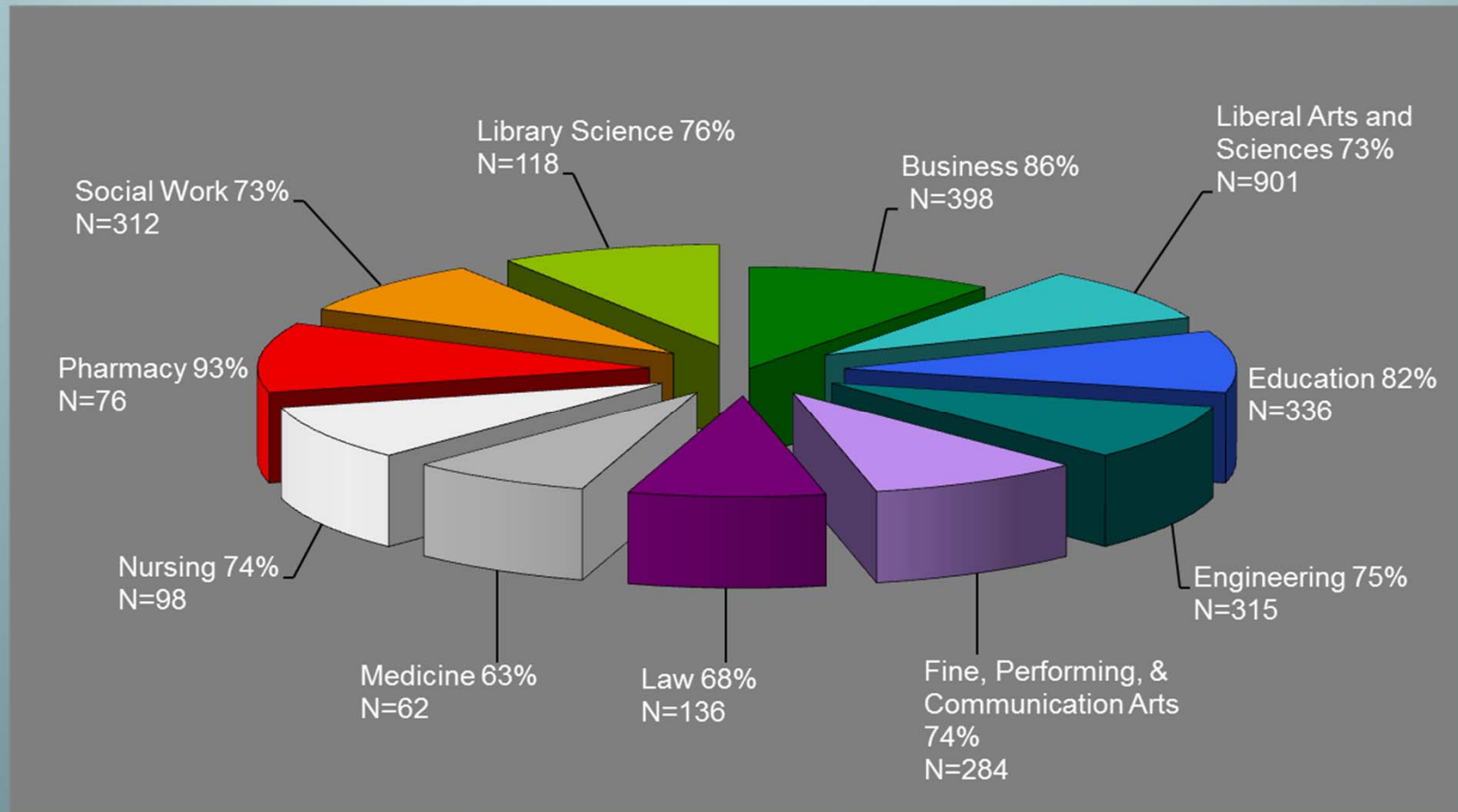

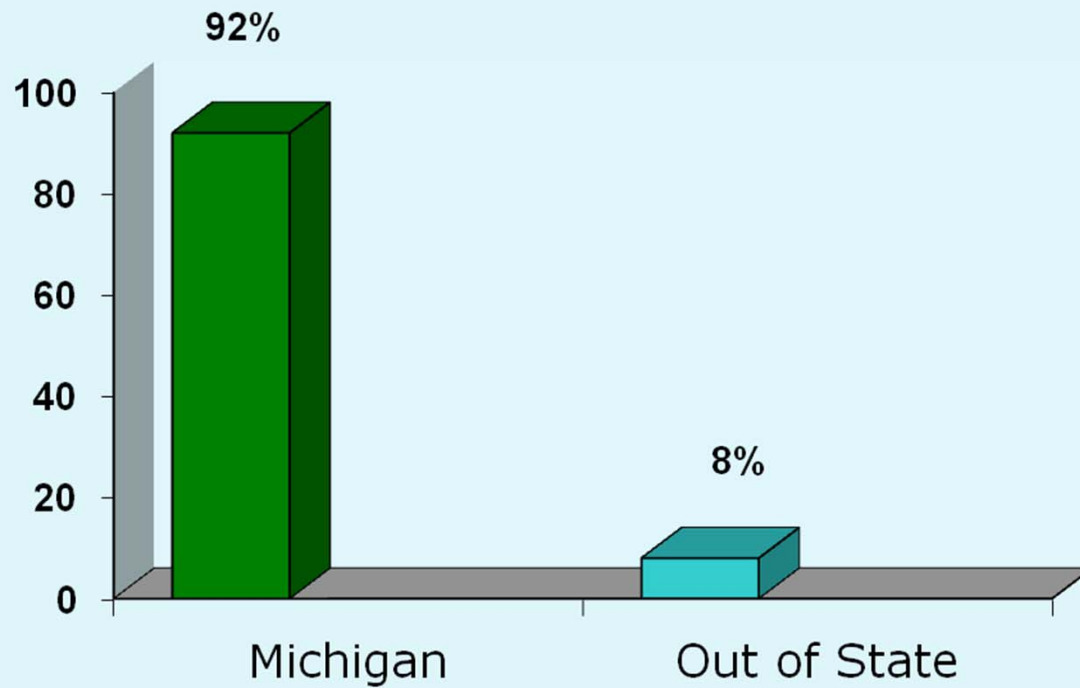
